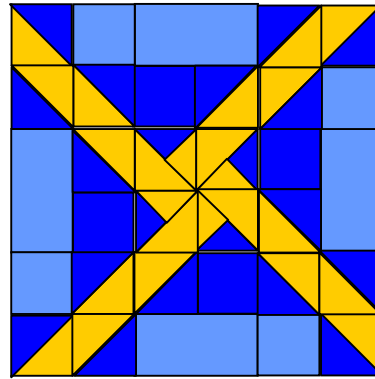




**Sierra Quilt Guild**  
**Block of the Month for AUGUST 2008**



**12 1/2" unfinished – PIONEER**  
**12" finished block**






**Cut:**

- Gold print**  
 8 - 3" square  
 4 - 3 1/2" square

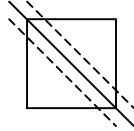
**Medium blue print**

-  4 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"  
 4 - 2 1/2" square

**Dark blue print**

-  4 - 2 1/2" square  
 8 - 3" square  
 2 - 3 1/2" square

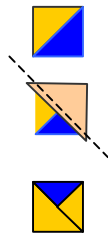
**Create HST:**



Mark the 8-gold 3" squares diagonally on the backside. Place right sides together (1 blue and 1 gold print) and sew 1/4" on each side of the marked line.

Cut on the diagonal line and press to the blue side. Trim HST unit to 2 1/2".

**Assemble 4 center subunits:**



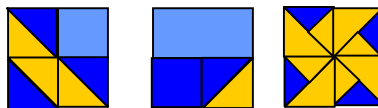
Use 2 each color of the 3 1/2" squares creating 4 HST.

Cut on the diagonal and press open. Do not trim. Mark HST diagonally on wrong side across seam

Cut the 2 remaining 3 1/2" squares diagonally. Place one as shown in diagram on each HST. Turn over and sew 1/4" from mark on HST. Trim seam to 1/4".

Open, press and trim to 2 1/2".


**Assemble units (4 each of outer 8 units, 1 of center unit):**



Outer - 4 each

center

Lay out your units very carefully. Then assemble them in 9-patch fashion as shown above.



**Pioneer Corn & Ham**

*2 cans cream style corn*  
*2 C diced ham*  
*2 1/2 C crushed corn chips*  
*1 med onion, diced*  
*1 large can evaporated milk*  
*Salt and pepper to taste*

Mix all ingredients together, reserving 1/2 cup of the chips. Pour in a greased casserole baking dish. Sprinkle with the 1/2 cup chips. Bake at 350 degrees until set, about 40 45 minutes.
