Samples of Quilt Categories

Art: More similar to a painting than a quilt.



Modern: Primarily solid fabrics with different scale of blocks and negative space. May have repeating blocks.



Traditional: Regularly repeating shapes based on a

grid. Simple or complex blocks, or fa-

miliar historical blocks where the rows and columns are the same block and/or size. Relies on symmetry with uniform sashing and borders.






Panel: Design incorporates a panel. Panel may have one large image or several smaller coordinating squares and rectangles.



Appliqué: Ornamental needlework in which pieces or patches of fabric in different shapes and patterns are attached onto a larger piece to form a

picture or pattern.











Handwork: Must be primarily hand embroidered and/or hand pieced and/or hand pieced and/or

hand quilted.





Artistic Fabric Creations: Wearable clothing, hats, purses, pillows, table runners, and other items not covered in any other category.



Chairman's Challenge: A

16x16" square quilted and bound block with 50% or more the actual color of the crayon chosen. Crayon must be attached to the finished quilt. Only one crayon may be used.
