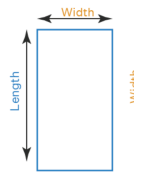


Sierra Quilt Guild 2026 Quilt Show Entry Instructions

Show Dates: Friday Sept 18th & Saturday, Sept 19th, Mother Lode Fairground:

Quilt Delivery Date: Thursday Sept 17th 8 am - 11 am, John Muir Building

Quilt Return Date: Saturday Sept 19th, 2025, 6:30 pm Sierra Building



Entry form Deadlines:

1. Early Due Date (get a free gift) **Monday July 28th**
2. Final Due date, **Monday August 10th** (Hard deadline)

Important Changes for 2026

Entry Limit - 5 quilts per quilter plus one Chairman's Challenge Quilt (mini-flags)*

Entry Size Limit - We have **10** extra large spaces for quilts larger than **90W X 100L**. Entries will be counted by the date received. Quilts larger than 120L may hang onto a floor drape.

Number of quilts accepted into the show is very dependent on the sizes of the entries. We are also hanging quilts by category. If we have too many entries, we will use our best judgement and may have to delay some entries to the 2027 Show.

* Guild Challenge Quilts (Under the Sea) DO NOT need an online entry. They are collected at the August 10th Guild Meeting

1. Complete the online entry form and submit photo at www.sierraquiltguild.com

OR

2. Office Hours - We complete your entry form, measure, and take photos, and print you a receipt. (You will also receive an email confirmation of your online entry)

Photo of your quilt:

For the Web Form, you will be able to attach the photo with the entry (online). For the Office Hours, we will take your photo and submit. If you have difficulty, you may email your photo to kyla@quiltpixie.com with a copy of your entry's email receipt.

Preparing your quilt for delivery

1. Each quilt must have a 4" wide sleeve on the back of the quilt at the top. The sleeve must be securely stitched down at the top and bottom edges. No pins.
2. Each quilt must have the Quilt Label* hand stitched onto the back of the quilt in the lower right corner. No pins or safety pins.
3. Deliver your quilt folded with the label showing.

Delivering Your Quilt

When you deliver your quilt on September 17th, you will be given an index card receipt. You must present the card when you pick up your quilt on September 19th.
