

Quilt Barn Art Teacher Anelie Belden

Students have these designs to choose from for class and the kit includes a pattern for the design they choose to do. The block design is 22" with added 1" border. Finished Project is approx. 24" (Note: When cutting the wood it is very difficult for it to be exact. The border gives us a little wiggle room to assure the design will not have points cut off the edges.) A pattern for the chosen design will be given in class. Students who wish to do their own design must have it drafted to size and please let me know so we can be sure it will work.

If getting a kit the following is in the kit. Or you can supply it yourself Kit fee is \$38.00

24" square piece of wood Pattern of your choice

Wood is prepared by having been sanded and have a basecoat on it (White)

Acrylic paint in colors being used for the Block (I will have a variety of colors to choose from. **Please bring your own if you have specific colors you want.**)

Carbon paper– enough to make a 22" square


2 sponge paint brushes

Students should bring the following to class

- 1 Large garbage bag to cover table
- Apron to protect clothing
- 2 containers– 1 for water and one for brushes
- Green Frog masking tape– 1 roll any width
- Paper Towels for easy clean up
- Pencil with an eraser
- Ruler to draw straight lines
- Hair drier or small fan to dry project quicker– this can be shared between a few people
- Ruler to draw lines 12" to 24"



Simple Star




