Viewer's Choice Category (you will select a category below) Workshop - A finished project from a 2025 SQG Workshop Bed Turning - Holiday Theme (minimum size 50x60)

Choose the Viewer's Choice Quilt Category: (Choose one)

Art: More similar to a painting than a quilt. Grid or repeating blocks are not used. Styles may vary and use a combination of fabric, paint, beads, piecing and threads.

Modern: Solid fabrics with a different scale of blocks and negative space. May have repeating blocks.

Traditional Larger than 50": Regularly repeating shapes based on a grid. Simple or complex blocks, or familiar historical blocks where the rows and columns are the same block. Relies on symmetry with uniform sashing and borders. Color placement is planned and repetitious.

Traditional Smaller than 50": See definition above.

Panel: Central design incorporates a panel. Panel may have one large image or several smaller coordinating shapes.

Appliqué: Ornamental needlework in which pieces or patches of fabric in different shapes and patterns are sewn or attached onto a larger piece to form a picture or pattern. Technique is accomplished either by hand and/or machine stitching.

Patriotic: A quilt made of red, white and blue fabric. It may contain stars and/or stripes. Any appliqué used to depict America and/or American History may vary in color.

Handwork: Must be at least 50% hand embroidered and/or hand pieced and/or hand quilted.

Artistic Fabric Creations: Wearable clothing, hats, purses, pillows, table runners and other items not covered in any other category.

Chairman's Challenge: A square quilted block 16"x16" with use of color from a crayon. Crayon must be attached to finished quilt.

Beginning Quilter: Began quilting within the last three years (2022 or later) and has made at least one quilt.

Junior Quilter: A quilt made by someone under 18 years of age.

Photo of your quilt:

For the Web Form, you will be able to attach the photo with the entry (online). For the Office Hours, we will take your photo and submit. If you have difficulty, you may email your photo to <u>kyla@quiltpixie.com</u> with a copy of your entry's email receipt.

Preparing your quilt for delivery

1. Each quilt must have a 4'' wide sleeve on the back of the quilt at the top. The sleeve must be

securely stitched down at the top and bottom edges. No pins.

2. Each quilt must have the Quilt Label* hand stitched onto the back of the quilt in the lower right corner. No pins or safety pins.

3. Deliver your quilt folded with the label showing.

Delivering Your Quilt

When you deliver your quilt on September 18th, you will be given an index card receipt. You must present the card when you pick up your quilt on September 20th.
