**Sunset** pattern available at Blossom in Oakdale (Charlotte will also have some), please purchase ahead of time.

Sewing notions

Rotary cutting tools: Mat, 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" ruler, a 4" or 4-1/2" square ruler, and a rotary cutter with containing a **new blade**.

Fabric according to pattern. (2 yds of background is great)

**NOTE:** This "complicated looking" pattern is really quite easy to make. Choose your strips either by a 2-color scheme such as yellow and blue, or red and blue. **OR** by a theme such as all Asian, polka dots, patriotic, batiks, Kaffe's, fall or Christmas colors, or? Background fabric can be light or dark to set off the strips to their best advantage.

The pattern calls for 48 2" strips. If you are using a jelly roll, you must cut the strips down to 2." This way it removes the zip-zag or pinked edges. And you must add 8 more strips out of your stash to get the 48.

**Homework:** We will be making 3 blocks in class. (Bed size calls for 12 blocks you can make at home.)

For class:

1. Sew together 12 assorted 2" strips. (Or all)
2. From the background fabric cut the following:
  - 1 strip 3-3/8" WOF\*
  - 1 strip 7-3/4" WOF
  - 1 strip 5-1/4" WOF

\*Width of fabric.
