## 2024 Quilt Show Entry Instructions

<b>Show Dates:</b>	Friday & Saturday, September 20 & 21, 2024
<b>Entry Form Deadline:</b>	Monday August 12, 2024
<b>Quilt Delivery Date:</b>	Thursday September 19, 2024, between 8am and 11am at the Fairgrounds, John Muir Bldg
<b>Quilt Return Date:</b>	Saturday September 21, 2024 at the Fairgrounds, Sierra Bldg, at about 5pm

### Preparing your quilt

1. Each quilt must have a 4" wide sleeve on the back of the quilt at the top. The sleeve must be securely stitched down at the top and bottom edges. No pins.
2. Each quilt must have the Quilt Label from the Entry Form hand stitched onto the back of the quilt in the lower right corner. No pins.
3. Deliver your quilt folded with the label showing.

### Completing the Entry Form

The completed entry form must include a color photograph. One form per quilt.

**Best option:** Download the entry form from the guild website, complete the form, email the form and the photograph to Kyla Lemon at Kyla@quiltpixie.com.

**Next Best option:** Bring your quilt to the Guild Meeting on July 8 or August 12 and a photo will be taken for you. Turn in your entry form at the same time.

**Good Option:** Complete the paper entry form. Write your name, the name of the quilt, the dimensions of the quilt on the back of the photograph. Mail the entry form and the color photograph, no larger than 5"X7", to: SQG Entry, PO Box 43, Standard CA 95373. Photographs will not be returned.

### Delivering Your Quilt

When you deliver your quilt on September 19, you will be given an index card receipt. This receipt must be presented at the time you pick up your quilt on September 21.

### Choosing the Quilt Description

**Art/Modern** - Could have fabric, paint, beads, threads. Might use negative space, improv piecing, trendy color combinations or graphic prints.

**Baby/Children** - a quilt designed or made specifically for a child

**Bed Turning Quilts** - quilts made by previous Featured Quilters

**Beginner/First Timer** - One of the first three quilts made by the Exhibitor or the first quilt ever entered in our show

**Guild Challenge** - mini quilt depicting a designated theme and fabric sample

**Handwork** - a majority of the technique used is hand embroidery, hand appliqué, hand piecing or hand quilting

**Machine Appliqué** - the majority of the technique used is machine appliqué

**Panel** - the central design incorporates a panel

**Traditional** - the design uses repeating shapes on a grid, with uniform borders and or sashing

**Vintage** - quilts over 50 years old

**Quilted & Other Items** - clothing, hats, purses, pillows and other using quilting techniques

**Workshop Projects** - quilt made at a guild workshop
